We are grateful to be working, playing and living on the traditional territory of Scia'new Nation and we thank them for this beautiful land. *Hych'ka* (thank you)

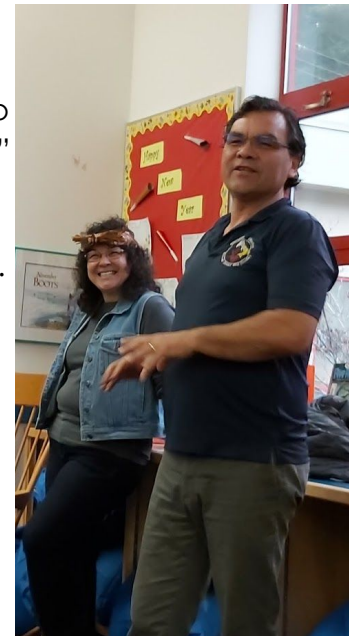
