First, we want to thank you all so much for the wonderful car parade last Friday. It warmed our hearts


to see those who were able to make it out.

We are hearing from many of you, that access to your child's supplies would be helpful right now. So we are packing them up and will have them available for you with a time allotted for you based on child's last name:

- A through G 9:00-10:00
- H through O 10:00-11:00
- P through Z- 11:00-12:00



**Please DO NOT come if you are sick in any way. We will make arrangements with you for another time.

Instructions for parents:

- Only the parent or guardian can pick up a child's belongings. We cannot accommodate family friends at this time.
- Please bring any library books you have at home. There will be a box for you to drop them off.
- Parents will walk around the side of the school to the side of the gym door and line-up.
 *To ensure physical distancing, markers will be set-up for the line-up.
- Once the parent has arrived at the first door, they will give the names of their children to the staff member.
- While the parent walks around the outside of the gym, past the basketball courts and turns down the driveway to the pick-up door and waits, the staff member will retrieve the student belongings.
- Note: Parents do not enter the building.
- Staff locate belongings and place them on the <u>pick-up table</u> at the pick-up door.
- Parent then exits down the side of the school and heads home.

If you are bringing your children, they are to be within an arm's length of you at all times on the property. Please do not stay and play.
