Thank you viewing our Welcome to Kindergarten slideshow, filling in the online survey and attending the Drive-Through where we were able to spend a few special moments meeting your family. Although we had to adapt our regular routine to align with physical distancing rules, we appreciate your participation and are looking forward to getting to know you better.

As you may know, kindergarten students begin a new adventure of exploration and learning with a gradual entry to school. Students usually have an orientation session in the Spring or September and then begin to attend school for a short period of time and a small group of peers, increasing in increments until they attend a full day with the whole class in attendance. They will get to know the staff and students as they learn school routines and expectations. This is an exciting time for your child, your family and the school staff as you begin together to establish a learning environment that is safe, caring, comfortable, caring and fun.

PLEASE NOTE: Our Kindergarten classes will be determined after we meet the students and get to know them. The entire Kindergarten team will be working with the children during the first couple of weeks of September and the students will doing activities in both Kindergarten classrooms. This will allow us to form balanced classes that support all students.

Each student will attend one orientation session and then start school on Monday September 13<sup>th</sup> following the gradual entry schedule posted below.
