### Daily Health Checks

In order to continue to keep our school the safe place it has been, we require the ongoing support and diligence of families when it comes to monitoring your child's symptoms of illness. Please continue to do a daily health check before attending school and remember to keep your child home if they are feeling sick. If they are feeling unwell and you are unsure about their symptoms, please call 8-1-1 or speak to a medical professional.

If a child presents as ill at school, we will call their parents right away and remove them from their class. Please continue to have a pick–up plan ready.

#### Safety Measures in the School

We remind everyone of the multiple layers of protection in place to provide safe learning environments for staff and students. Some of the health and safety measure that are directed by the PHO, School District and School based-staff include:

- Mandatory mask wearing for K-12 indoors
- Maximizing space between people where possible
- Reinforcing a one-way direction around the school to reduce involuntary contact
- Classrooms using different entry/ exit ways
- Classrooms entering the school one-at-a-time to avoid crowding around the doors
- Floor markings such as arrows and decals to maximize spacing
- Readily available hand sanitizer for every room and entryway
- Encouraging students to practice hand hygiene and mask wearing
- 3 large Playground Zones to maximize spacing of students outside and when they line–up to come back inside
- Meetings held virtually
- Limiting visitors in the school
