Early Dismissal Day:

<u>Thursday, November 24th</u> is early dismissal day to accommodate parent/teacher conferences. Students will be dismissed at 11:38. Buses will run their usual routes but everything will be three hours earlier. Expect to pick up your child from their bus stop three hours before their regular end of day time.

Non-Instructional Day:

<u>Friday. November 25th</u> is a non-instructional day for students. Staff will be engaging in various professional development opportunities.

Winter Concert:

Mr. Epp and all of our HH students have been hard at work preparing for our Winter Concerts which will take place on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>December 15th</u>. We will have an afternoon performance at 1:00pm and an evening performance at 6:00pm. The performance will run for approximately 1 hour.

In order to comply with fire regulations, we need to keep track of the number of our audience members. All spectators **MUST** have a ticket in order to attend either performance. Tickets are FREE. You will not be able to enter the performance without a ticket as there will be limited seating.

We are anticipating that each performance will be busy. For this reason and to be equitable to all families, we are allowing families to order 2 tickets for each performance initially. So, that will be 4 tickets total between the two performances. On December 8th, if there are any remaining tickets for either performance, we will add one more ticket per family where additional tickets were requested until all tickets are accounted for. Should there be any remaining tickets, we will go back to families who requested further tickets on a first come first served basis based on the order of received requests.

We do expect the afternoon performance to be less popular than the evening performance as many of our families work during the day. If your family is hoping to bring extended family, please consider asking for your extra tickets for the afternoon performance. Please order your tickets through the link below which will go live tomorrow, <u>November 24th</u> <u>at noon</u>. Tickets will be sent home with your child closer to the performance date.
