# Remembrance Day Assembly:

Our school will be having our Remembrance Day Assembly on <u>Thursday, November 10th</u> starting at <u>10:45am</u>. This ceremony will be led by three of our Grade 5 students. We will have a guest do our Territorial Acknowledgement. The choir will be singing and the whole school will also be singing. Two classes will have students presenting reflections or poems about Remembrance Day. We will have students from each class present their class wreath during the ceremony. Parents are welcome and encouraged to attend. Chairs will be set up for parents along one end of the gym.

#### Dress for the Weather:

A friendly reminder to please send your child(ren) dressed for the weather as we will be playing outside at recess and lunch every day rain, snow or shine. We want to make sure kids are warm enough and can stay dry with coats and boots. If your child tends to find the puddles, feel free to send an extra set of clothes in their bag. #### Hold and Secure Drill:

On Monday, November 21st, we will be practicing our Hold and Secure drill. This drill involves keeping students in their classrooms and locking doors to keep any unsafe situation out of the classrooms. Students will be asked to position themselves in their rooms away from the door and windows so that they are hiding. This is only a DRILL to practice what to do in the event of an intruder in the building. Staff will walk the students through the drill step-by-step and will communicate very clearly that this is only a PRACTICE so that kids are not scared. The drill will only last for a short amount of time. We wanted to inform families in case your child comes home and talks about it afterwards so that you have the information to be able to reassure your child should any concerns arise from the drill.
